Course Focus: Child care skills with special emphasis on child safety. A Canadian Red Cross certificate will be issued upon completion of the course. This course is designed for students 10-15 years of age. It teaches the basics of babysitting, rights and responsibilities, getting along with participants, holding, diapering, feeding, bedtime, toys and activities, accident prevention and handling emergencies.

The Babysitting Course will be here at our school on the following Tuesdays: April 4, 11, 18, and 25th from 2:40 – 4:40 p.m. Cost is \$50 per student.
