Indigenous Sport, Physical Activity and Recreation Council Launching of Fraser Athlete Development Program

This is a high-performance camp that will train and prepare young athletes to overcome physical and mental obstacles to reach their goals. Athletes will train twice a week from April until June in Strength & Conditioning, Gymnastics, and Sprinting under the tutelage of experience NCCP certified coaches. We will be running one program in the Langley area and one in the Seabird Island/Chilliwack area to accommodate athletes living across the Fraser Region. **This program is ideal for Team BC athletes who will be heading to the North American Indigenous Games in July, but we also welcome athletes of all skill levels and disciplines.**

There is a cost associated to this program, HOWEVER Indigenous athletes who commit to the program are eligible for reimbursement.

We invite all interested athletes to register, and we will also be hosting a Feast and information session on Friday, March 31st to speak more about the program. For all interested coaches, we will also be hosting a free coaching clinic on Sunday, April 2nd to give you the skills needed to assess your athlete's basic skills.
